NCOA's Benevolent Funds

- NCOA Scholarship Fund** – Scholarships are awarded to children and spouses of NCOA members. These are non-repayable and are renewable for up to three years after the initial grant.
- NCOA Betty Ross Educational Fund** – Open to NCOA Auxiliary members, this fund provides scholastic grants for developing or improving upon a member's employment skills.
- NCOA Medical Fund** – A fund designed to assist dependents of noncommissioned and petty officers with medically-related incidental expenses. Non-repayable grants and no-interest loans are awarded to help defray associated costs of catastrophic illness.
- NCOA Disaster Relief Fund** – Provides relief for immediate disaster-related needs to military members and their families who suffer losses as a result of natural disasters such as hurricanes, fires, floods, earthquakes, etc.
- NCOA National Defense Foundation** – Serves America's veterans in state and federal health care and nursing facilities, residents of the Armed Forces Retirement Home, and provides unique opportunities for Armed Forces personnel and their families.

Membership Divisions

- **REGULAR DIVISION:** Grades E-4 through E-9, in all branches of the U.S. Armed Forces, active duty, Reserves, National Guard, and retired and separated personnel who held rank of NCO/PO at time of separation from active duty under honorable conditions.
- **VETERANS DIVISION:** Veterans of any branch of the U.S. Armed Forces, regardless of rank or grade held at time of separation from active duty under honorable conditions.
- **APPRENTICE DIVISION:** Active duty Grades E-1 through E-3 in all branches of the U.S. Armed Forces.
- **ASSOCIATE DIVISION:** Active duty officers who were former NCOs/POs, NCOs of allied military services, and immediate family members of former members or persons who would have been eligible for membership in the Regular or Veterans Division. Also includes friends of the military who do not qualify for one of the other divisions of the Association.
- **INTERNATIONAL AUXILIARY:** Spouses/former spouses, widows/widowers, and family members 18 years of age or older of enlisted members, whether active duty, separated, veteran, Reserve or National Guard, in Grades E-1 through E-9.
